

Players of Code Red, please take notice.

Here are the new insurance guidelines for eye protection, masks, and goggles.

All eye protection/goggles must have a full seal made of rubber or foam. A strap is required; if you don't have one, we sell them in the pro shop.

must be Ansi Z87.1 or ASTM F2879 approved and properly fit the face without any gaps.

All masks must be Ansi Z87.1 or ASTM F2879 approved and have a strap that fits them properly. No mods or zip ties

Any novelty mask like an army of two etc. from Evike or other source will need and second pair of Eyewear underneath (still will need approval.)

What's Not Permitted.

Shop glasses. All Gas masks. Pit vipers. Heatwaves. Oakley without a Helo kit and strap.

Any Integrated goggles in a helmet

No mask / goggle system with flexible lens like snowboarding goggles.

Any knockoff goggles majority are not Ansi Z87.1 or ASTM F2879 approved.

Any mask or goggles without a full seal of rubber or foam and that are **NOT** Ansi Z87.1 or ASTM F2879 approved are prohibited.

Although we have never experienced an incident, your eye safety is very important to us, and following these guidelines will ensure that we don't have an incident. We recognize that this may cause some inconvenience, but it is necessary for your own safety. If you are unsure about your eyewear when checking in, you can ask the pro-shop staff to check them out. Hope this clears up any confusion. And remember don't go cheap on eye protection not worth it.
